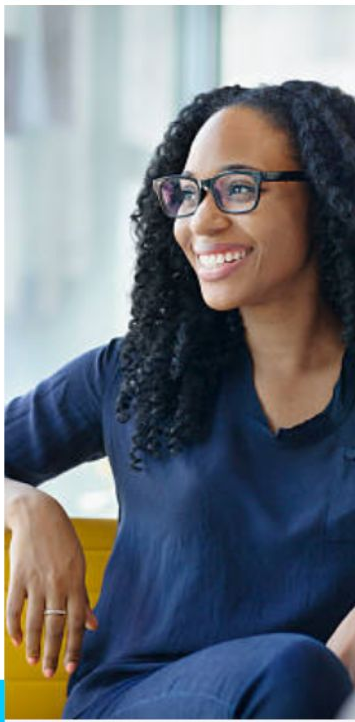

Utility access to electric ports and wifi access are required.

Small area nearby with table or flat surface to display eyewear.

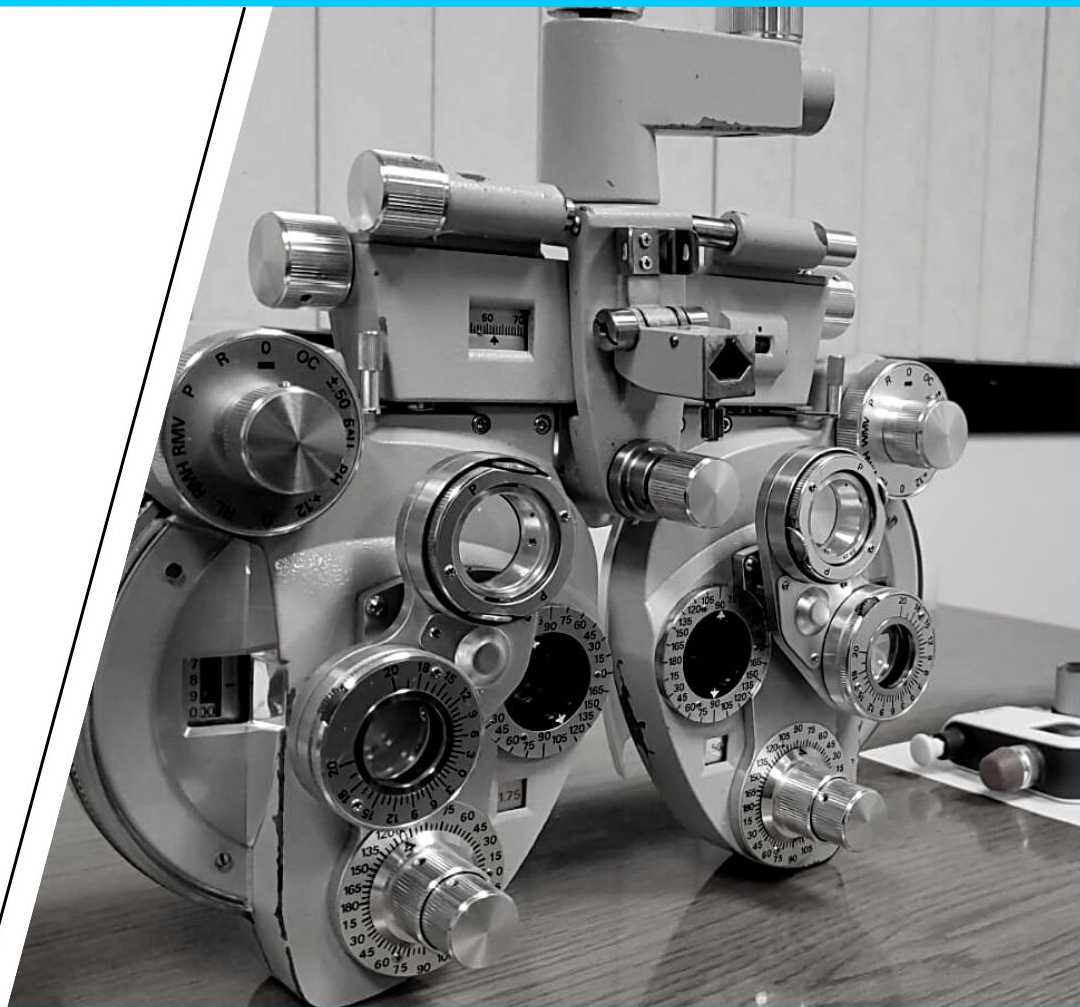

The Exam Component



Preliminary performance process

1

- Medical history
- Habitual eyewear and chief complaints discussions
- Incoming visual acuities (far and near)

2

- Confrontations (hand-count visual fields)
- Autorefraction
- Lensometry
- Fundus photos
- IOP

3

- Synopsis of initial conversation
- Questions answered
- OD hand-off

Comprehensive performance process

1

- Review of preliminary work-up and symptoms

2

- Anterior and posterior segment health check

3

- Refraction and prescription finalizing
- Review of findings and questions answered before hand-off back to technician/ optician



Retinal Imaging

During comprehensive exams, retinal cameras with advanced imaging technology capture the detailed structures of the back of the eye including the optic nerve, retina and blood vessels.

The high resolution of these photographs advances the care and early diagnosis of potentially harmful disorders such as glaucoma, macular degeneration, and diabetic retinopathy.





Optical Displays

On-site eyewear dispensary can be set up and adapted to fit almost any available space. All that's needed is a nearby table or a flat surface.
